RFP Questions and Answers: Fabricator and Installer of Temporary Artwork for the Southeast Treatment Plant Construction Fence Temporary Artwork Program

1. Do individual artists qualify as an installer/fabricator?

Individuals may qualify as long as they are able to perform the requested scope of services, and are willing to become a registered <u>City Supplier</u> and enter into a <u>P-600 Professional Services</u> Contract with the City.

2. How to handle insurance as an independent artist?

The vendor must carry Commercial General Liability and Auto insurance <u>as required by the City</u>. If the vendor has employees, it must also carry Workers Compensation insurance, as well as meet the requirements of the City's <u>Minimum Compensation</u> and <u>Health Care Accountability Ordinance</u>.

3. Can alternative materials be used?

Due to the scale of the artwork and requirements of the site, only mesh vinyl may be used for the temporary artwork banners.

4. Deadline to execute the art installation on the fence?

The artists for the 2023 and 2024 program years have already been selected and approved by the Commission. Once installed in the Fall of each program year, the artist's artwork banners are to be fully replaced every four months until the following Fall when the next artist's work is installed.

5. Are the fund allocations available as costs are incurred or after the two years? It is expected that the vendor will invoice only for work that has been performed (as costs are incurred). The vendor payment schedule for each program year will be negotiated as part of its contract with the City.
